There will be an orientation and information session on **Friday, October 14, from 2:00 to 3:45, in Furman Hall, Room 212**, regarding dedicated summer internships, including those within the International Law and Human Rights Fellowship Program, the International Law and Development Fellowship Program and the Hague Conference on Private International Law. **Current full-time first year JD, second year JD, LLM and JSD students at NYU School of Law in New York and Singapore are eligible to apply for the ILHR Fellowship; LLMs in New York and Singapore for the IFD Fellowship; and 1Ls and 2Ls with PILC summer funding are eligible to apply for The Hague Conference internship.**

**INTERNATIONAL LAW FELLOWSHIPS FOR JD AND LLM STUDENTS**

The **International Law and Human Rights Fellowship Program** (ILHR Fellowship Program) is coordinated by the Center for Human Rights and Global Justice (CHRGJ) in cooperation with the Institute for International Law and Justice (IILJ) with the support of the Public Interest Law Center (PILC). The Fellowship has two major components – a research paper and an internship in summer 2012 at one of 26 prominent international organizations, including, but not limited to, international tribunals (e.g., ICTY, ECCC, Special Tribunal for Lebanon); UN organizations (e.g., International Law Commission, UNHCR, OHCHR); and international and national NGOs (e.g., ICTJ, Interights (London), Egyptian Initiative on Personal Rights, Rainbow Rights Project (Philippines), Legal Resources Centre (South Africa) and Defense for Children International – Sierra Leone). Students who are current full-time 1L, 2L, LLM and JSD students in New York and Singapore are eligible to apply.

The **International Finance and Development Fellowship Program** (IFD Fellowship Program) for LLM Students is coordinated by the Office of Graduate Affairs. The Fellowship has two major components – a research paper and an internship at one of 6 prominent international organizations: EBRD, IDLO, IISD, IMF, WIPO and World Bank. Students who are current full-time LLM students in New York and Singapore are eligible to apply.

Selection of Fellows for both Fellowship Programs is competitive, through an application and interview process. The ILHR application, which will include descriptions of all internship placements, will be available on October 14 on the CHRGJ, IILJ and Graduate Affairs websites ([www.chrgj.org](http://www.chrgj.org) and [www.iilj.org](http://www.iilj.org), [www.law.nyu.edu/graduateaffairs](http://www.law.nyu.edu/graduateaffairs)) and at the meeting that day. The IFD application is currently available on the Graduate Affairs website ([www.law.nyu.edu/graduateaffairs](http://www.law.nyu.edu/graduateaffairs)). Applications for the IFD Fellowship will be due on Wednesday, November 2, and applications for the ILHR Fellowship will be due on Wednesday, November 9.

**OTHER INTERNATIONAL LAW INTERNSHIPS FOR JD STUDENTS**

**The Hague Conference on Private International Law Internship**

Selection for an internship at The Hague Conference on Private International Law will be subject to its own application and process for which applications are expected to be available in late January 2012. This internship is coordinated by Professor Linda Silberman. Eligible students are 1Ls and 2Ls who qualify for PILC summer funding.

If you are interested in the Fellowship Programs or The Hague Conference internship, but are not able to attend the October 14 meeting, information is also available as follows:
